The Vernon Township School District is pleased to announce the opening of the PowerSchool Parent Portal on January 4, 2010, which will enable parents of students in grades 4-12, to review their child's grades and daily attendance from home or work.

PowerSchool Parent Portal gives parents and students access to real-time information including attendance, grades and detailed assignment descriptions, school bulletins, and even personal messages from the teacher. Everyone stays connected: students stay on top of assignments, parents are able to participate more fully in their student's progress, high school students can pre-register for courses, and teachers can use their grade book to make decisions on what information they want to share with parents and students.

In order to gain access to this valuable tool, a computer internet connection is necessary. The web address of the PowerSchool Parent Portal is: <https://power.vtsd.com>. Please save this address in your Internet favorites or create a shortcut to your desktop. It will surely be a website you will want to check on a regular basis.

Once connected, each parent and student will need a user name and password. User names and passwords will be mailed during the week of December 28 and should arrive by Monday, January 4. Once you are logged in, explore each area by clicking on the icons at the top of the page. By clicking on the question mark at the far upper right corner, information can be displayed to answer any questions you may have on the operation of the portal.

If you have questions regarding grading or attendance, please contact your child's teacher or the school's attendance officer. If you have not received a user name and password by the first week in January, please contact your school's main office.
