



Bus Safety

We will be having a Bus Safety Program at Walnut Ridge Primary School on Wednesday, September 14th. Students will have an opportunity to board the buses and learn about bus safety from the bus drivers themselves! Thank you to the bus drivers who will graciously teach students about bus safety.

Here are Bus Safety rules that you can share with your child(ren):

1. Take their seat quietly.
2. Remain seated for the entire ride.
3. Talk quietly.
4. Keep aisles clear.
5. Don't disturb the driver.
6. Obey all rules and follow all directions given by the bus driver.

Below are some more Safety Rules to encourage with your child(ren):

1. Students should put everything into their backpacks before walking to the bus stop.
2. Practice crossing the street and looking both ways before crossing.
3. Tag and running games should not be played at the bus stop.
4. Your child(ren) should stand at least 6 feet from the road while waiting for the bus.
5. Your child(ren) should stand 6 feet away from the bus until the driver says it is OK to enter the bus.
6. Children should never stop to pick up any objects that they drop near the school bus. They should ask the driver for help. The driver may not see the child if he/she bends down to pick up an object!
