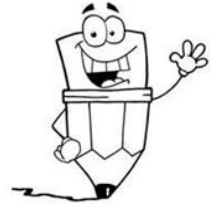


Dear Future Second Grader,

Soft pencil case with zipper (no hard cases)
Box of 24 crayons/colored pencils
1 pink eraser
1 box of sharpened #2 Ticonderoga pencils
2 black/white composition book (not spiral)
6 glue sticks (labeled with student's name)
2 sturdy pocket folders
1 pair of scissors
1 yellow highlighter
1 small pack of markers

MATH/SCIENCE

Soft pencil case with zipper (no hard cases)
Box of 24 crayons/colored pencils
1 pink eraser
1 box of sharpened #2 Ticonderoga pencils
2 spiral bound 1 subject notebooks
6 glue sticks (labeled with student's name)
2 sturdy pocket folders
1 pair of scissors
1 yellow highlighter
1 package of thin black dry erase markers
(low odor)

Please remember this is a starter kit and supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year.

An assignment pad will be given to you on the first day of school. **Calculators, rulers, binders, and Trapper Keepers are not needed.** A **healthy snack** will give you an energy boost during the day, so be sure you bring one daily.
