

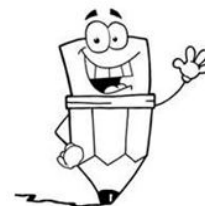
Dear Future Second Grader,

### **LANGUAGE ARTS/SOC. STUD.**

Soft pencil case with zipper (no hard cases)  
Box of 24 crayons/colored pencils  
1 pink eraser  
1 box of sharpened #2 Ticonderoga pencils  
2 black/white composition book (not spiral)  
6 glue sticks (labeled with student's name)  
1 pair of scissors  
1 yellow highlighter  
1 small pack of markers

### **MATH/SCIENCE**

Soft pencil case with zipper (no hard cases)  
Box of 24 crayons/colored pencils  
1 pink eraser  
1 box of sharpened #2 Ticonderoga pencils  
1 package loose leaf wide ruled paper  
6 glue sticks (labeled with student's name)  
1 pair of scissors  
1 yellow highlighter  
1 pack of thin dry erase markers (low odor)

### **SHARED LA/MATH**

1 1-Inch Binder  
Soft zippered pencil pouch with 3 ring binder holes  
4 folders (1 preferably with holes for the binder)  
1 package plastic subject dividers

**Please remember this is a starter kit and supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year.**
