Dear Parent/Guardian:

Educational research reinforces what we all know: good teachers make a positive difference. Quality teachers are those that have a strong knowledge base to teach in their assigned subject area(s) and training and preparation in teaching or pedagogy. In New Jersey and in Vernon Township, all teachers must demonstrate that they have this knowledge and training in order to be fully certified teachers and be employed.

A provision of the Title I law requires all districts to notify parents of all children in Title I schools that they have the right to request and receive timely information on the professional qualifications of their children's classroom teachers. Specifically, you have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- Whether New Jersey has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subject(s) he/she teaches.
- Whether New Jersey has decided that the teacher can teach under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications. It is important to note that Vernon's district aides are not considered paraprofessionals.

Since Cedar Mountain and Rolling Hills Primary Schools have been designated a Title I school for the 2018–2019 school year, please call your child's principal if you would like to receive any of this information.
