(Take into account summer plans. For example, being on a plane or on a car trip allows reading for a long stretch of time, but sleep away camp might not.)

Where can I find ideas for book/text choices?

-  Check out books the local library, or borrow from a friend/family member!
-  Read a book before or after you see the movie!!
-  Listen to an audio book!

So what is expected from our summer of "**FREEDOM**" when we return in September? When you read a good book, it's only natural to want to share it. In short, seventh-grade and eighth-grade readers should be prepared to share their reading "**FREEDOM**"!!
