Dear Vernon Parents/Guardians:

This letter is to inform you that a student from the **Gold Team** at Vernon Township High School has been identified as a confirmed case for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). We have just received the test results. The student was not in school yesterday or today. The last time the student was in the high school was Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>. The Vernon Township School District is currently coordinating with Sussex County Department of Public Health Nursing and is following CDC, state and local health department guidance in order to assure the health and safety of our community.

Due to this potential exposure, we have informed the parents of the students who are in this student's classes and the student's teachers. All involved will be quarantined. We are taking more precautions than necessary to make sure all of our students are safe.


