Dear Vernon Parents/Guardians:

This letter is to inform you that a student from Lounsberry Hollow has been identified as an assumed confirmed case for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). We have just received this diagnosis from the student's pediatrician. The student was last in school Tuesday, November 10th. The Vernon Township School District is currently coordinating with Sussex County Department of Public Health Nursing and is following CDC, state and local health department guidance in order to assure the health and safety of our community.

Due to this potential exposure, we have informed the parents of the students who are in this student's classes and the student's teachers, and any close contacts. All involved will be quarantined. We are taking more precautions than necessary to make sure all of our students are safe.

We are in the process of cleaning and disinfecting all of the exposed areas. The school is also taking precautions to prevent the introduction and spread of viruses and other germs and will be doing increased sanitizing this evening.

As always, we appreciate your support and cooperation. You can assist us by remaining vigilant but sensible in your approach to dealing with this health concern.
