Dear Vernon Parents/Guardians:

This letter is to inform you that three related Vernon students, one in Glen Meadow and two at Vernon Township High School have tested positive for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). We have just received this diagnosis from the Department of Health. **It is important to note that all three students' last day in school was November 4th and according to the Sussex County Department of Public Health and Nursing we do not need to quarantine any students or staff and do not need to close either Glen Meadow or the high school at this time.** It is also important to note that these students have had no contact with any of their peers through sports, clubs or any activities since November 4th.

The Vernon Township School District is currently coordinating with Sussex County Department of Public Health Nursing and is following CDC, state and local health department guidance in order to assure the health and safety of our community. We are continuing the process of cleaning and disinfecting all our schools and will continue to take precautions to prevent the introduction and spread of viruses and other germs and will be doing increased sanitizing this evening.

As always, we appreciate your support and cooperation. You can assist us by remaining vigilant but sensible in your approach to dealing with this health concern.
