Dear Parents/Guardians:

This letter is to inform you of several new COVID cases in the district. One faculty member at Rolling Hills Elementary School has been identified with a positive case for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). We have just received the test results. That faculty member's last day in school was Tuesday, November 24. All close contacts have been notified and instructed to quarantine based on the guidance of the Sussex County Department of Public Health Nursing. In addition, a faculty member from Lounsberry Hollow School tested positive for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). The last day of attendance for that faculty member was Tuesday, November 24. All close contacts have been notified and instructed to quarantine based on the guidance of the Sussex County Department of Public Health Nursing. The Vernon Township School District continues to coordinate with the Sussex County Department of Public Health Nursing.

In addition one student at Glen Meadow and one student at Rolling Hills (related) have tested positive for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). The last day those students were in attendance was Monday, November 23. All close contacts have been notified and instructed to quarantine based on the guidance of the Sussex County Department of Public Health Nursing.

At Lounsberry Hollow School one student has tested positive and one student at Vernon Township High School (related) have tested positive for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). The last day the students were present in school was Monday, November 23. All close contacts have been notified and instructed to quarantine based on the guidance of the Sussex County Department of Public Health Nursing. We continue to take necessary precautions and are in the process of cleaning and disinfecting all areas of the building in addition to our normal cleaning and sanitizing procedures.
