

Athlete Registration Information

All students who participate in sports must provide a NJ Department of Education Sports Physical prior to participation. [HERE](#) The school nurse will determine if the student has submitted all necessary medical documents and information prior to participation in any sport.

Students New to Athletics: Please complete the online registration for your activity on our Athletics - Registration tab [HERE](#). You will need to create a new family online account with your login and password if you are the first member of your family to participate in a school sport. You will use this account for all sports in upcoming years, for all siblings in your family.

Returning Athletes: Please complete the online registration for your activity on our Athletics - Registration tab [HERE](#) using your existing family login information.

Please deliver a paper copy of your NJ Department of Education Sports Physical (DO NOT UPLOAD) to our school nurse, Ms. Ash. In order for your NJ DOE Sports Physical to be valid, your exam ***must have been performed within 365 days of the first day of practice / try-outs***. If your NJ DOE physical took place more than **90 days** before the first practice, we need "NJ DOE Health History Update Questionnaire". [HERE](#)

Final clearance by the school nurse must be approved in order to play. Reasons that you will not be cleared to participate in try-outs, practice or games include:

- ❖ If your NJ DOE Sports Physical took place more than 90 days before the first practice, we need "NJ DOE Health History Update Questionnaire" [HERE](#)
- ❖ Online family registration not created
- ❖ Paper copy of NJ DOE Sports Physical not received by our school nurse
- ❖ Incomplete NJ sports physical paperwork (missing signatures, etc.)
- ❖ Date of last physical exam is more than 365 days prior to the first practice
- ❖ Incomplete immunization status
- ❖ Missing doctor's orders, such as
 - Asthma Action Plan signed by your doctor if you use an inhaler
 - Allergy Emergency Action Plan signed by your doctor if you are prescribed an Epi-Pen
