Accessing the program:

- Teens and young adults must have a diagnosis of an intellectual/developmental disability.
- Funding is provided by private donations. There is no fee for this service.
- Completion of SCARC Camp forms and attendance at mandatory parent zoom meeting.
- Campers must be independent in self-help skills and able to wear a face mask throughout the day

Session Dates:

- Session #1 June 21-July 2, 2021 ages 13-21
- Session #2 July 5-July 16, 2021 ages 21-25
- Session #3 July 19-July 30, 2021 ages 13-21
- Session #4 August 2-August 13, 2021 ages 13-21

Activities: All activities take place in the community. Past activities have included:

- Bumper boats and miniature golf
- Turtle Back Zoo and Claws N Paws Zoo
- Planetarium
- Picnics/Outdoor sports/swimming
