Dear Parents/Guardians of Eighth Grade Students:

The Eighth Grade Dance is scheduled for Friday, June 11, 2021. Listed below are the guidelines regarding this special event. We would ask all parents/guardians to please review these guidelines with their children so that the dance can be an enjoyable social experience for everyone.

General Guidelines

1. The Eighth Grade Dance is only open to eighth grade students who attend Glen Meadow Middle School.
2. The dance will commence at **6:00 p.m.** and conclude at **9:00 p.m.** Parents/Guardians or pre-authorized adults, older brothers or sisters over the age of 18, etc. must sign out and escort the student out of the school between 8:45 and 9:00. We ask that you please be prompt when picking up your child.
3. As a reminder, when students are inside the building masks must be worn.
4. Students will only be admitted to the dance **ONCE**.
5. Appropriate behavior and conduct is expected at the dance; students disobeying school rules and disturbing the rights of others will be dismissed from the dance. Provocative dancing or inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated and violators will be asked to leave the dance. Parents/Guardians will be notified of any such behavior and will be requested to pick up their child immediately.
6. Students are expected to dress in a manner age appropriate for the dance. Teachers will use discretion and will not permit any items of clothing with vulgar or obscene slogans or footwear that could be considered unsafe. Dance attire includes dresses, slacks, dress pants, collared shirts.
7. Students absent from school the day of the dance may not attend the dance. Students must remain in school for four hours in order to be considered present for the day. No student may be picked up prior to 12:00 noon if they are attending the dance.
8. Students are strongly encouraged to attend without a "date" and the use of limousines is not permitted.

All parents/guardians are requested to cooperate with the school regarding the above-mentioned guidelines and, in particular, are reminded to pick up their child promptly by 9:00 p.m. Please complete the entire attached permission form and return to school no later than June 11th.
