

Out of District School Transportation

If Vernon Twp. Schools are delayed or closed due to weather, all out of district routes will be affected in the same manner.

Sussex County Technical School/Sussex County Charter School for Technology

Vernon currently has 4 bus routes that go to both Sussex Tech & Sussex Charter. Because of the length of the routes and the number of students being transported, buses stay on main roads and bus stops are generally limited to intersections that can be utilized by multiple students.

Private & Choice School Transportation

Vernon does not currently have any bus routes to private schools or choice schools. If your student attends Pope John/Rev Brown, those schools provide busing for the 2022-2023 school year and you can contact them for information. All other students who live within 30 miles of their private/choice school are eligible for aid in lieu of transportation. You should receive a letter explaining this process over the summer.

Out of District Special Education Schools

Vernon provides transportation to out of district special education schools. If there is any special information that would help your child have a smoother ride to school, please inform their case manager so that information can be relayed to the bus company prior to the beginning of the year.

Most of these routes are done with minivans/minibuses. Drivers are not directed to enter driveways or other private property. Parents must aid a student in loading/unloading unless there is an aid on the vehicle. Drivers and

aides cannot leave the vehicle to help students out of/into the home or the school. A parent or school personnel must bring the student to the vehicle.

If no one is home to receive the student and we are unable to reach the parents or emergency contact, students will be brought back to their school and will have to be picked up there. Please be sure you have a plan in place should you be unable to receive your child.
