COMMUNITY- Spanning 70 square miles and home to over 20,000 residents, Vernon Township is located in the Northeast corner of Sussex County and is situated approximately 52 miles from New York City. Currently, the district enrollment is over 2,900 students and consists of one high school, two middle schools, two elementary schools and one preschool.

SCHOOL- Vernon Township High School is a comprehensive high school enrolling over 950 students in grades 9-12. The school first opened in 1975 and is accredited by the NJ Department of Education. The curriculum is the heart of the school and builds on the skills learned in the primary school levels by emphasizing higher level thinking and career related programs. We run an eight period rotating schedule with a unit lunch. Classes meet for approximately 40 minutes daily. In addition to Advanced College Preparatory and Honors/AP programs, students may also elect to pursue their interests in program sequences in the areas of; Business, Fine and Performing Arts, Hospitality, Allied Health and Career and Technical Education (CTE). Vernon has also partnered with several Colleges & Universities so that students may choose to enroll in concurrent college level courses. They include; Fairleigh Dickinson University, Syracuse University, Rutgers University, Seton Hall University and Sussex County Community College. Vernon Township High School has a rich set of extracurricular offerings to supplement its core academic program including 28 athletic teams and over 55 clubs & organizations.
